

Great Moor House, Exeter - Secure Store

Our Contracts Team created a secure store for all Devon County records including births, deaths and marriage records with the existing first floor warehouse space in Great Moor House.

Project Objective

To form a fireproof and waterproof store for statutory records within an existing first floor area whilst the rest of the building was fully operational and thus ensuring that no disruption was caused to the end users or the general public.

Description and Approach

A 'room within a room' needed to be constructed including a fully guaranteed roof structure and membrane together with an integral ventilation system to create the records store, which needed steel security doors at both ends. In tandem with this a small office was created and provision for a new doorway into the existing store together with all associated works required including mechanical and electrical installation, partitioning, suspended ceilings, plastering, handrails to roof, decorations and floor finishes.



Completion & Handover

All works were completed on the agreed handover date, with minimal snagging and disruption to the end users at Great Moor House, their staff and visitors.
